Vintage 2015

Cuvee aged in Cognac & Red Wine Barrels

ABV: 12%

Brewed: 2015 **Bottled:** 2018 **Release Date:** May 2019

Roxy is based on a trappist ale aged in a mix of Cognac and Bordeaux barrels blended with a soured barleywine for extra complexity and a touch of balancing acidity

Enters with a tight tan head on a dark chestnut beer with red highlights. Aroma is dried dark plums, sour cherry, vanilla. The complexity of the nose carries through on the palate with coconut, dark chocolate, and caramelized figs. Viscous mouth feel with chest warming alcohol and salted caramel finish.

FREYA

Vintage 2015

Stock Ale aged in Cognac Cask

ABV: 8,5%

Brewed: 2015 **Bottled:** 2018 **Release Date:** May 2019

Blend of dark trappist ale and traditional milk stout, that spent two years on a cognac barrel. Some of the sugar from the milk stout is unfermentable leaving some body to this otherwise dry and crisp beer. A beer that is surprisingly refreshing for its color and alcohol level.

Almost black with chestnut highlights and tan head. Initial aroma is dark chocolate with hints of coffee but as it warms up vanilla overtakes. The dark chocolate continues in the flavor with tobacco and coffee, topped up with prunes, burned sugar and sour cherries. Finishes with bright acidity, balsamic sweetness and a lingering roasted note.

JULIE

VINTAGE 2015

Single barrel Sour Ale

ABV: 6%

Brewed: 2015 **Bottled:** 2018 **Release Date:** May 2019

This is our first single barrel release. This golden ale had a used champagne barrel as its home for over three years. During that time the relatively simple beer underwent an amazing transformation where it picked up color, texture and aroma from the barrel while the micro organisms in Garden Party went to work on the fermentable sugars.

When we tasted it we decided the result was so spectacular that we could not bring ourselves to blend it or otherwise tamper with it. Orange-amber with white head. Bright acidic aroma dominated by red fruits and leather. On the palate the first impression is bright fruity acidity followed by macerated strawberries, rhubarb and a hint of caramel and toasted walnuts. Medium bodied with a dry, clean finish and refreshing acidity.

ANGELA

Vintage 2015

Red ale with Black Berries

ABV: 7%

Brewed: 2015 **Bottled:** 2018 **Release Date:** May 2019

Every autumn the forests around our brewery are bursting with small wild blackberries. We spent some days with friends picking them for a beautiful tart red ale that had been aging in red wine barrels since 2015.

The result is Angela, a chest nut colored ale with a cream head. Aromas of prune, vanilla and toffee dominates, followed by the flavor of ripe blackberries, pepper, caramel, red wine and toasty malts. Medium bodied with juicy, tart finish and hints of aged balsamic.

LINNEA

Vintage 2015

Aged Brown Ale

ABV: 5%

Brewed: 2015 **Bottled:** 2017 **Release Date:** Nov 2018

Chestnut colored ale with a tan head inspired by the Belgian “oud bruin” style. After wild fermentation on red wine barrels for about a year, it is going through a short controlled vinegar-fermentation. Light aroma of balsamic vinegar, sour cherries and cocoa. Flavour is dominated by toffee and toasted malt, with the tartness balanced by bready sweetness.

Tasting notes update April 28th 2019

After two years in the bottle Linnea has developed in a remarkable way. The acidity is dialled back and the slight acetic touch is also milder than it was in the "fresh" bottles. A delicious but unexpected overtone of chocolate is now the dominating flavor. It is fascinating how how Garden party continues to transform this beer.

GENEVIEVE

Vintage 2015

Hoppy Golden Ale

ABV: 5%

Brewed: 2015 **Bottled:** 2017 **Release Date:** Nov 2018

Hoppy golden ale with primary fermentation taking place in steel with English ale yeast and matured in used champagne barrels, with our wild yeast culture for a year, after which it is dry hopped for freshness. Crisp, dry and sparkling with intense aroma of citrus, passion fruit and freshly cut grass. Effervescent mouth feel with biscuit-like malt and tart, fruity flavor.

NINA

Triple Cuvée Blend Amber Ale

ABV: 6%

Brewed: 2015 **Bottled:** 2017 **Release Date:** Nov 2018

This cuvée of three beers (a sour brown fermented with wild yeast, a blonde ale fermented with brettanomyces yeast and a clean saison) has been matured in a 2400 liter chianti foudre for 18 months before release. After maturation we only packaged two thirds and left the rest of the beer in the barrel, where it was topped up with fresh beer. A form of simplified solera system, that provides complexity and aged notes to the beer in a year or two. Light amber with complex aromas of red currant, plum and a touch of vanilla from the oak. Slightly tart with hints of caramel and a soft lingering finish.

TERRY

Brewed: 2015 **Bottled:** 2018 **Release Date:** June 29th
2019 | **Vintage:** 2015

A few weeks every year the forests on Bornholm are home to small tart raspberries brimming with flavor. 2017 was a wet and cold summer, but we still managed to pick a small amount, that all went into 500 liters of a beautiful tart amber ale which which had already spent two years on a sherry cask. The berries sparked a second fermentation, which added further acidity and complexity. She is rosy dark amber with cream head. Light raspberry with hints of pepper, rose petals and balsamic in the aroma followed by ripe raspberry and fruity acidity. As it warms sherry like notes and toasted grain appear. Dry tea-like aftertaste with lingering acidity.
